Confucius Institute Scholarships 2017

Scholarship for a Master Degree in Chinese teaching (2 years)

Criteria: Bachelor degree or equivalent, HSK 5 (>180), HSKK Intermediate (>50), Age below 45. ([Click here for information about the HSK tests](#)).

Coverage: Registration fees, tuition, fees for basic learning materials, accommodation fees on campus, monthly living allowance, outpatient medical service and comprehensive insurance for foreign students studying in China. Monthly living allowances are CNY 3,000 per month.

Scholarship for One-Academic-Year at a Chinese University

Criteria: HSK 3 (>180), HSKK Beginner (>60), Age 16-35. ([Click here for information about the HSK tests](#)).

Coverage: Registration fees, tuition, fees for basic learning materials, accommodation fees on campus, monthly living allowance, outpatient medical service and comprehensive insurance for foreign students studying in China. Monthly living allowances are CNY 2,500 per month. Courses include Chinese language, history and philosophy.

Scholarship for One-Semester at a Chinese University

Criteria: HSK 2 (>120), HSKK Beginner (>40), Age 16-35. ([Click here for information about the HSK tests](#)).

Coverage: Registration fees, tuition, fees for basic learning materials, accommodation fees on campus, monthly living allowance, outpatient medical service and comprehensive insurance for foreign students studying in China. Monthly living allowances are CNY 2,500 per month. Courses include Chinese language, history and philosophy.

Scholarship for the International Summer School (ISS) at Renmin University (4 weeks)

Criteria: Students at Copenhagen Business School or Copenhagen Business Confucius Institute, Age 18-30. ([Click here for information about the HSK tests](#)).

Coverage: Scholarship winners are exempt from tuition fees. In addition it is possible to apply for free accommodation. Courses include Chinese language, business courses, history etc ([Click here for more details](#)).

Chinese Bridge Scholarship for University students (2-4 weeks)

Criteria: University students aged 18-35. Winners are selected at the yearly Chinese Bridge competition at Copenhagen Business School.

Coverage: Scholarship includes a trip to the Chinese Bridge final in China during Summer 2017. All expenses are covered except visa fees.

Chinese Bridge Scholarship for High School students (2 weeks)

Criteria: High School students aged 14-20. Winners are selected at the yearly Chinese Bridge competition at Copenhagen Business School.

Coverage: Scholarship includes a trip to the Chinese Bridge final in China during the Autumn 2017. All expenses are covered except visa fees.
